

Firebelly Toad

Latin Name	Bombina orientalis
Native to	China, Korea, Southern Russia
Maximum Length	1–2 inches
Life Span	7–15 years
Enclosure	Use screen-glass top combo terrarium or screen top with removable cover panels to maintain humidity. Communal: multiple toads recommended. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10–15 gallon for 2–3 toads• 20 gallon for 4–6 toads Provide shelter and climbing options such as a half-log, plants, or mopani wood.
Substrate	coconut fiber (EcoEarth)
Temperature	ambient, day 70–75°F, night 60–68°F
Light	diurnal Ambient light or incandescent/LED lighting for viewing, 10–12 hours daily.
Humidity	tropical, 70–90% Use a fogger or mist toads with distilled water daily. Keep substrate moist.
Water	Provide purified water in a large bowl.
Food	insectivorous Feed daily: small crickets dusted with calcium/supplement powder May sometimes offer small mealworms, caterpillars, or small feeder guppies.
Shed Cycle	daily to every 2 weeks Toad will eat skin as it sheds, usually at night.
Sexing	male: nuptial pads (thick black pads on forefeet) and may bark mating call
Maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Remove food debris.▪ Rinse water bowl, replace water.▪ Feed crickets.
